The City of St. Augustine is soliciting Bids for the replacement in full of an existing duplex can pump station with a new duplex submersible pump station including wet well, receiving manhole, piping, pumps, bypass assembly and piping, suction assembly and piping, electrical equipment and concrete pad located on Institute Street within the incorporated City limits of St. Augustine, Florida 32085, in FDOT right-of-way between Institute Street and Orange Street to the west of Hwy U.S. 1, abandonment of approximately 5,880 LF of existing 10" forcemain by cut, grout, and plug.
