



TALKING TRASH

A helpful guide to Residential Solid Waste Services

Household Garbage

What: Kitchen & bathroom waste. General household trash

When: Once-a-week.

Monday – North of King St.

Tuesday – South of King St & Anastasia Island

Note: One 65 gallon brown cart is provided per each single family home. These are only for household garbage, not to be used for yard trash or construction debris. Carts may be placed curbside after 6pm the day before service and must be removed by 6pm the day service is rendered.



Recycling

What: The city offers a single-stream program, which enables the user to co-mingle multiple items such as flattened cardboard, all paper, waxed fiber, plastic bottles & containers, glass bottles, packaging Styrofoam, and egg cartons. Residents must empty and rinse containers to eliminate contamination.

When: Once-a-week.

Thursday – North of King St.

Friday - South of King St. and Anastasia Island.

Note: One 65 gallon green cart is provided per each single family home. These are only for household garbage, not to be used for yard trash or construction debris. Carts may be placed curbside after 6pm the day before service and must be removed by 6pm the day service is rendered.



Yard Waste

What: Limbs and brush under 4 yards must be placed curbside. Loose debris such as grass clippings and leaves must be in bags or containerized to not exceed 50 lbs. and 32 gallons, each.

When: Once-a-week.

Wednesday

Note: For large yard waste disposal such as stumps, logs and limbs over 2" in diameter, 50 lbs. per container or 4 yards of total debris, the homeowner is responsible for disposal. If a tree, lawn or landscaping service/company does the work, they must haul the debris or charges will apply.
