



Instructions For Using This Map:

1. Locate the property
2. Refer to the corresponding color to determine the sign zone
3. Parcels adjacent to the Entry Corridors have additional design standards
4. Historic sign zones are also subject to the Architectural Guidelines for Historic Preservation
5. Refer to Chapter 3 "Advertising and Signs" of the Land Development Code for specific regulations
6. Visit www.staugustinegovernment.com and click on "City Code"
7. Download forms and guides on the "Forms, Applications, and Docs" link from the city website
8. Obtain an approved sign permit prior to ordering or installing any signage including temporary signage
9. Signs are usually processed at the time of submittal
10. Contact the department for any assistance
