Dockage Rates

Slips are reserved, just as moorings are reserved. We assign slip space based on length and beam of your vessel, and duration of your visit.

Transient dockage rates are as follows:

*Long-term dockage is based on availability of South Dock (max 49ft) (\$21ft / month)

*Dockage for vessels under 20ft will be billed at a 20ft minimum

*Commercial Dockage (Contract Required): \$25.00ft / month

If the City determines that the proposed business use of the dock space would provide a more substantial impact on the marina facilities, the commercial dockage rate shall be adjusted, as set forth in an agreement between the commercial entity and the City.

Dinghy Dockage: \$15.00 / day

Motorized vessels with length-over-all of 12 feet or greater, will not be considered for dinghy dockage.

Upon arriving in the vicinity of the marina, please contact the Marina Office on CH 16 or CH 71 from your VHF radio. If you do not have a radio on board, call our office at 904-825-1026.

You will be instructed as to the tie-side for your lines and fenders, and asked to standby as you prepare your lines and fenders for docking.

Once you have lines and fenders secure and ready, the marina staff will direct you to your slip. You will be met at your slip by a Marina Attendant who will assist you by catching lines and getting you securely situated at the dock. Swipe cards will be provided for access to the secured restrooms, showers, laundry, and lounge, upon registration at the Marina Office.

If timing, weather, and space allows, you are welcome to stop at the fuel dock to sign-in, register, and collect restroom/laundry keys. By taking care of these details before going to your assigned slip, it eliminates the need for you to return to the Marina Office once you are docked.
