## Mooring Field Rates

Moorings are reserved, just as dockage is reserved. We assign moorings based on length and draft of your vessel, and duration of your visit. If a mooring ball is open, please do not assume it is available for the taking. Effective October 1, 2023, mooring rates are as follows:

Upon arriving in the vicinity of the marina, please contact the Marina Office on VHF CH 16 or VHF CH 71. You will be directed to your mooring assignment by marina staff.

Once you are secured on the mooring, we ask that you come to the Marina Office to register and settle your account.

Dinghy dockage is complementary to all registered guests. Proximity cards will be provided for access to the secured restrooms, showers, laundry, and lounge, upon registration.

To ease the process of your arrival, we suggest stopping at the fuel dock, if it is convenient and weather permits. This is a good time to off-load trash, top off fuel, register, and collect your keys and dinghy sticker. By taking care of these details before going to the mooring, you can get settled and come to shore at your leisure.
