



**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE CITY OF ST. AUGUSTINE, FLORIDA
RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY 20-51 (COVID)
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 20-18**

Consistent with the Governor of Florida's Executive Order No. 20-51 and 20-52, as extended, modified, or amended, under the authority granted by the City of St. Augustine's Charter, Article IV, Division 4, and pursuant to Resolution 2020-10, the City Manager, or the Assistant City Manager as designated by the City Charter, or their designee, may make administrative orders and rules that have the full force and effect of local law during the pendency of a federal, state or local emergency or public health emergency. All existing laws, ordinances, and rules inconsistent with the provisions of sections 252.31-252.90, Florida Statutes, or identified as inconsistent with the directives of the State Health Officer and Surgeon General pursuant to their authority under Chapter 381, Florida Statutes, shall be suspended during the period of time and to the extent that such conflict exists. The City Manager, Assistant City Manager, or their designee, may issue administrative orders in support of these public health emergency directives to provide more efficient and orderly preparedness and recovery. Consistent with public health emergency directives of the State of Florida, the City Manager or designee may waive the procedures and formalities otherwise required, when reasonably necessary to preserve the health and welfare of the public.

Consistent with City of St. Augustine Resolutions 2020-20, 2020-21, and 2020-39 the City Manager, or their designee, specifically authorizes the following alternative meeting locations for specified boards or committees and providing for attendance by means of communications media technology of specified meeting attendees:

- 1) Meetings may be scheduled and held in the Mobility Conference Room on the 2nd floor of City Hall for the following boards and committee:
 - a. The Board of Trustees for the City Employees' Retirement System,
 - b. The Board of Trustees for the Municipal Firefighters' Pension Trust Fund,
 - c. The Board of Trustees for the St. Augustine Police Officers Retirement System,
 - d. The Audit Committee; and
 - e. The Civil Service Board.
- 2) Meetings may be schedule and held at The Willie Gallimore Center for the Lincolnville Community Redevelopment Agency Steering Committee.
- 3) Outside vendors and administrative staff required for participation in the above enumerated board or committee meetings may participate utilizing telephonic or other communications media technology.
- 4) All Health and Safety Protocols pursuant to Administrative Oder No. 20-17 remain in full force and applicable to the above enumerated board or committee meetings.

In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, persons needing a special accommodation to participate in public meetings should contact the City not later than seven (7) days prior to the meeting.

Any administrative action taken on or after the effective date of Resolution 2020-10, is hereby ratified.

This Administrative Order shall expire when the Florida COVID-19 State of Emergency expires, as it may be extended, modified, or amended from time to time.
